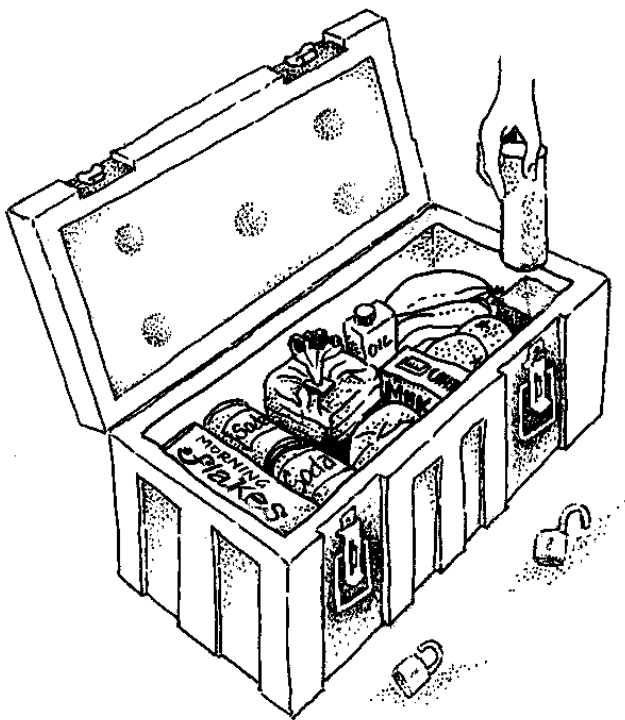
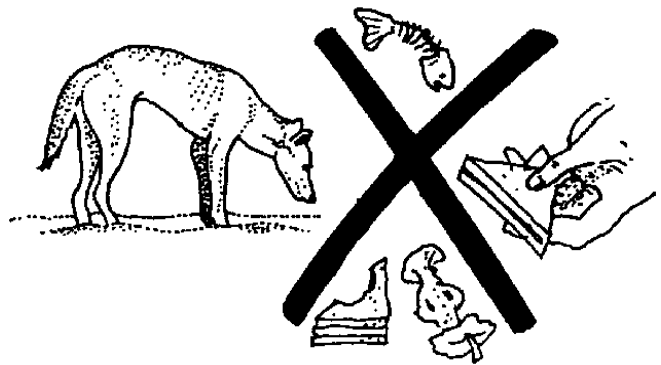

Be Dingo Safe

- Always stay with your children.
- Walk in groups.
- Do not encourage or coax dingoes.
- NEVER feed dingoes.
- Lock away all food, rubbish and iceboxes.



Anywhere on Fraser Island, on public or private land, it is an offence to feed a dingo, attract it using food or food waste, or disturb it in any way.

**Maximum penalty \$3000.
On-the-spot fines apply.**
